



**Mole Wetherell** is the artistic leader of Reckless Sleepers creating and producing the companies' theatre projects and installations. Trained as a visual artist in the late 1980's he joined Station House Opera as a maker and performer, throughout the 1990's he focussed on site specific and intimate performance projects for Reckless Sleepers, whilst also developing the rehearsal studio space PreSet.

In 1996 he was commissioned to create a large sound piece (Donkey 1996) for the European Football Championships. In 2002 he developed a 2-year site-specific programme of works for the National Museum of Scotland in Edinburgh.

In 2002 he has asked to be a resident Artist at Nieuwpoort theater Gent, creating Quiet Time, The Last Supper and A house on a Hill.

For the last 10 years Mole has lived and worked in Belgium in that time completing a 3 year research programme called A-trophy (acts of terror) a project that supported the early development of a range of collaborative projects that led to the production of Theatre projects Spanish Train, The Pilots, Nord Oost, the sound installation After Dubrovka commemorating the 5-year anniversary Moscow theatre siege and the production of a book documenting devising processes called Trial.

From 2008 - 2011 Mole directed a remake of Schrödinger's Box now called Schrödinger, launched a new graduate programme called Club Reckless creating and tours large scale contemporary performances with young people. The projects included This is not America parts 1 - 3, Daddy Cool & 16 Bodies for (Manchester Met. University) Die young stay pretty and Scarborough light for (University of Hull Scarborough) Daylight Robbery for (Northampton University) and WW1.1 for (K.A.S.K. Gent)

Mole is now busy producing the Reckless Sleepers touring projects Schrödinger the Last Supper, and the new dance piece by Leen Dewilde called a String Section.

A new project called Negative Space was designed and directed by Mole in 2014. Whilst also directing a new Italian translation of The Last Supper. Research continues with the take over project E M P I R E

In his spare time Mole has designed and rebuilt two spaces a working studio and a home.

Mole now works in his studio in Gent and lives in Drogen with Leen, Charlie (girl) & Mitsie (cat).
